What Is It?

The Mobility Ramp Program uses Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds received from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to pay for portable mobility ramps for very low and low income homeowners who cannot afford them.

Am I Eligible?

If you answer yes to the following questions you may be eligible:

1. Do you have a medical condition or disability that makes it difficult for you to navigate steps?
2. Is your household income at or below the limits listed in the chart?
3. Do you own your home or mobile home.?
4. Is your home homesteaded without liens?

What Are the Income Limits?

Family Size	Income Limits 80% AMI
1 Person	\$32,100
2 Person	\$36,700
3 Person	\$41,300
4 Person	\$45,850
5 Person	\$53,200
6 Person	\$56,900
7 Person	\$60,550
8 Person	\$64,190

Revised Income Limits of 2014

IF YOUR ADJUSTED INCOME IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE AMOUNT LISTED FOR YOUR FAMILY SIZE, THEN YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE.

What Do I Need To Bring When I Apply?

You will need the following items when you fill out your application:

- Drivers License
- Social Security Card

Most Recent Copies of the following (if applicable):

- Two Pay Stubs
- Benefit statements for any type of Public Assistance (Social Security, Unemployment, SSI...)
- Pension or Retirement Income statement
- SIX Bank statements (all accounts)
- Statements showing any dividend, interest and/or annuity income
- Tax return and W-2's
- Child Support Documents
- Copy of Divorce Papers
- Updated Property Tax Receipts
- Deed for Property
